\*\* A "Non-Official" version of the Technical Inspection Form is available on the CDBA Website for use at home or pre-race. The "Official" technical inspection form will be issued upon registration at the race site.

## **Technical Inspection Instructions:**

- The driver will perform his/her own inspection and check off each item as it
  pertains to him/her on the official tech sheet issued by registration personnel. Do
  not sign the inspection sheet until witnessed by the L.O.D.B.R.S. inspector.
- When the driver has completed this, he/she may look for an L.O.D.B.R.S. official inspector to complete the inspection process.
- The inspector will examine the technical inspection sheet and make sure that
  everything has been entered properly. After the inspector has found it to be
  correct, the inspector will ask the driver to sign and date the technical inspection
  sheet.
- After this has been completed, both the driver and the L.O.B.D.R.S. official
  inspector will approach the boat. The inspector will perform another inspection,
  confirming everything is true and completed correctly. The inspector will issue a
  sticker indicating that the boat has passed the inspection.
- The driver will then return the technical inspection sheet to registration personnel to be cleared to compete. The technical inspection sheet must be returned by the *driver* as the driver's armband will be placed on his/her wrist at that time. This will indicate that the driver and boat have been cleared to race.
- Repeat all of the above for secondary driver.
- Every boat is subject to random inspections.

\*\*Note: Each driver is responsible for keeping his/her pit area clean. Make sure that when changing the oil, using penetrating sprays, or transferring fuel that nothing is left on the ground, grass, or pavement. Do not discard oil in the garbage cans or dump on the ground. Ask at the CDBA trailer if anyone is collecting oil for that race or be prepared to pack it out with you. Please keep your pit area free of garbage (including cigarette butts) and that nothing is left behind when you leave for your trip home.
